# **CLINICAL CONSIDERATIONS**

### **TREATMENT FOR COVID-19**

The FDA <u>announces</u> **a Blood Purification device** that can be used to treat patients with COVID-19. Although this treatment option is only authorized for patients who are 18 years or older, positive for COVID-19 and admitted to the ICU with respiratory failure, this update **offers new HOPE!** 

**Remdesivir, Hydroxychloroquine, Chloroquine,** and **several other drugs** remain under investigation as potential solutions. Find more information here.

#### **SLEEP APNEA AND COVID-19**

The AASM states there is **no evidence to support linking sleep apnea to COVID-19** risk. Along with the recommendation to continue CPAP use, there are special considerations for patients using a CPAP if they develop symptoms of COVID-19 found <u>HERE</u> and include:

- Washing hands before and after handling CPAP equipment
- Clean CPAP equipment
- Change filters and accessories
- Avoid exposure to smoke
- Limit pet exposure to CPAP equipment
- Use distilled water in the humidifier

## POTENTIAL VACCINE IN DEVELOPMENT

The University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine published a study in *EBioMedicine* showing their ability to **build on previous experience with SARS-CoV in 2003 and MERS-CoV in 2014**. The **potential vaccine** follows a more established approach, unlike other experimental mRNA vaccine candidates. More information can be found <a href="here">here</a>.

- Studies in mice have shown the vaccine produces sufficient SARS-CoV-2 antibodies to resist infection within 2 weeks
- Vaccine delivery would be through a microneedle array


## **BUSINESS CONTINUITY PLANNING**

Catalyst Health Network reached out to all of the networks **174 practices** in the past six days in a full court press to help with the **Paycheck Protection Program application process**.

We will be reaching out to practices next week to follow-up and ensure practices have the support they need.

StratiFi Health, who provides financial management for physician led organizations, assisted in the completion of **18 applications representing a total relief of \$9.6M.** 

As of Thursday afternoon, 5 (28%) applications were funded and the clients have received \$1.5M. An additional 3 (17%) applications received an approval, but not yet funded, for \$3M.

#### **PAYER UPDATE**

#### **ALERT: IMPORTANT NOTICE!!!**

Due to recent payer updates, we can now recommend you use the **modifier 95 and POS 11** for telehealth visits with **ALL** your Catalyst Commercial payer contracts.

**NEW! Cigna** has **updated** their <u>policy</u> to align with CMS. Cigna now recommends using the **modifier 95 and POS 11** for telehealth claims.

**UHC** <u>announces</u> they have implemented actions for **accelerated payments** and processing of claims and are **extending timely filing limits** for claims with a date of service on or after 1/1/2020 if submitted by 6/30/2020. UHC has also provided a <u>telehealth coding guide</u> with examples of different **telehealth** scenarios.
